Please consult the monthly calendar, which will be sent home at the start of each month, for more detailed information. MISSION: The mission of East New York Prep is to provide a rigorous curriculum, disciplined environment and supportive community where students are academically and socially prepared to excel in demanding college preparatory high schools.

WIGS: East New York Prep's Wildly Important Goals (WIGs) are Culture, Literacy & Numeracy.

Culture: We seek to establish a THINK culture of excellence. We will accomplish this culture by focusing on our THINK (Tolerance, Hardwork, Integrity, No excuses, Knowledge) core values and on college readiness. Please check the monthly school calendar for ENYP Culture Days.

Literacy: We seek to ensure all ENYP Scholars are excelling on New York State English Language Arts assessments. To accomplish this we have a school-wide PARP (Parents as Reading Partners) competition from October through January. Please check the ENYP monthly calendar for the dates of specific PARP activities. All families are encouraged to participate!

Numeracy: We seek to ensure all ENYP Scholars are excelling on New York State Math assessments. To accomplish this we have a school-wide PAMP (Parents as Math Partners) competition from February through May. Please check the ENYP monthly calendar for the dates of specific PAMP activities. All families are encouraged to participate.

NOTES: (*) = **No Students.** All faculty and staff are in attendance for Professional Development and/or Clerical Days.

{ } = **Parent Teacher Conference Days:** Conferences will be held from 3pm - 6pm on Nov. 6, Feb. 12, April 30 & June 25. Full day conferences will be held from 8am to 6pm on Nov. 11, Feb. 17 & 18, and June 28th. Please schedule your individual conference session (for each marking period) directly with your child's teacher.

▨ = **First and Last Day of School:** The first day of classes for all kindergarten and newly admitted ENYP Scholars is August 31st. The first day of school for all returning ENYP scholars is September 3rd. The last day of classes for all ENYP Scholars is June 25th.

Extended Day Program: During the month of September students are dismissed at 2:45pm. Starting Thursday, October 1st students are dismissed at 4:30pm Monday through Thursday. On Friday, from October through June, student are dismissed at 2:45pm for teacher Professional Development.

Marking/Grading Periods: East New York Prep follows a quarterly marking period during the academic year. Each Marking Period contains approximately 45 days each. Report Cards are distributed at Parent Teacher Conferences.

First Quarter Marking Period: The first marking period runs from September 8th through October 30th.

Second Quarter Marking Period: The second marking period runs from November 1st through February 5th.

Third Quarter Marking Period: The third marking period runs from February 8th through April 23rd.

Fourth Quarter Marking Period: The fourth and final marking period runs from April 26th through to June 18th.

Assessments: East New York Prep administers several assessments throughout the academic year. Interim and NYS Assessments are mandatory assessments and students must be in attendance. Please consult the monthly ENYP calendar for the exact dates of student assessments.
